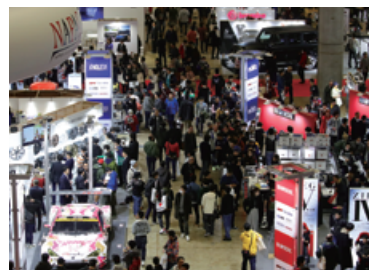

New Era Brings New Phase in TAS 336,060 Go Wild over Ingenious Booths

The first TOKYO AUTO SALON in the new imperial era *Reiwa* has turned out to be extremely successful with record-smashing 336,060 attendance. Looking at the current trend in the automotive industry, eco-cars have been skyrocketing in popularity, of which electric vehicle (EV) deployment has been growing rapidly. Thus there is an increasing tendency for people to ride a car in factory default. Such the industry-wide trend notwithstanding, TOKYO AUTO SALON beat our own record again which is an impressive proof that a lot of people still have passion for customizing their vehicle purely for a fulfilling car life.

Enthusiasm and commitment for custom cars have long been sort of a guy thing - particularly of Japanese men. However there has been a positive shift in the visitor segment. Young people, women and families are noticeably on the increase to make up an important share of our current fan base. Overseas visitors have also grown considerably and their fervour could break the mold of conventional concept in the Japanese custom car scene.

The major automakers and foreign car importers have all been driven by this felicitous change to get actively involved in the custom car culture. TOKYO AUTO SALON in recent years has also been identified as a significant platform by such the industrial giants to unveil their new car including world premiere model as well as announce their motorsport activities for the year. Some of them even take sales orders for their new model which is previously unimaginable event.

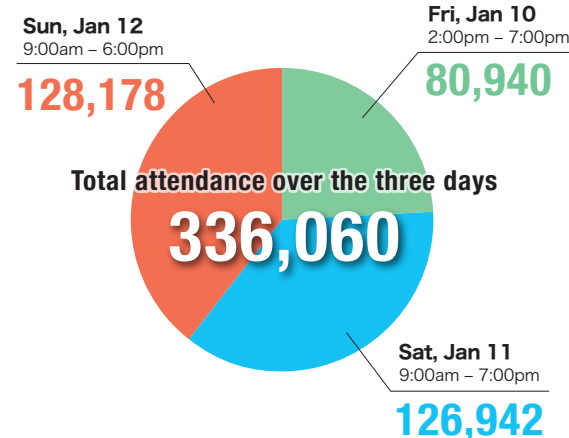

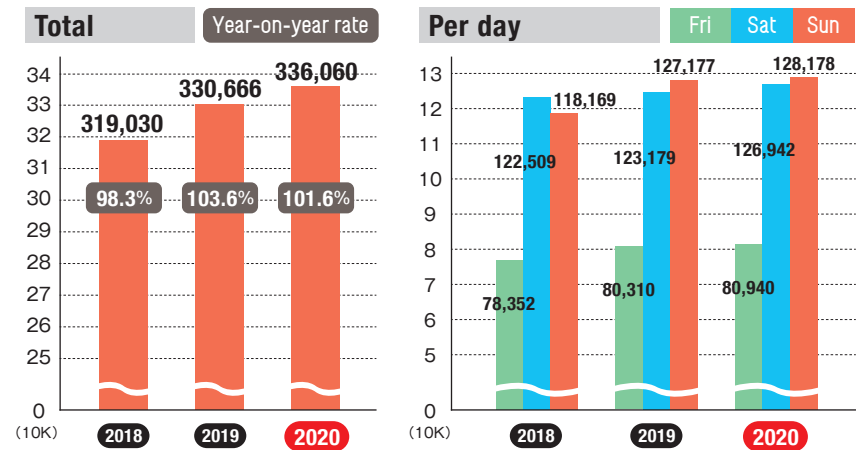

Diversified Content for Diverse Visitors

TAS is a Mecca for Those Love a Cut Above the Rest

TOKYO AUTO SALON creates a real buzz of excitement over the weekend though the show gets underway in a bit sober atmosphere. Friday 9am to 2pm are reserved for media and industry professionals as “silent time” where the exhibitors take full advantage of the opportunity to have a presentation and make new business contacts. As TAS has now ever-increasing conferences in a packed 5-hour schedule, you need to check the timetable carefully and get clear on your priorities which to attend.

The press conferences are all imaginative and newsworthy which are now another signature TAS content. You will see an automaker unveiling a new car in here and a wheel manufacturer launching a new product in the booth next to them; you will then come across an European car importer just a few blocks away proclaiming a new brand by its CEO; some other automaker announcing their motorsport activity for the year in the booth opposite; and their major competitor introducing rookie paddock girls in another hall.

Although the number of exhibitors and cars on display were not ahead of the previous record, more spacious booths and ampler aisles offered more contentment to the visitors. The fragmentation of consumer needs for cars has resulted in a healthy increase in the visitors to each booth as well as overall attendance.

After the Opening Ceremony and a subsequent brief calm, the Event Hall is all set for “SUPER GT AUCTION – TAS”. The third car auction in TOKYO AUTO SALON is the first-ever racing car auction in Japan jointly organized by SUPER GT. The auction is proven by the success of the previous occasions that it is the content to intrigue many people from both home and abroad alike, and the heated bidding ends with the highest bid of 165,000,000 JPY. More entertaining content follow in the coming days at the Event Hall: “The Japan Race Queen Awards” on Saturday, and “AUTO SALON SPECIAL LIVE” with the gorgeous lineup of performers both on Saturday and Sunday evening. The venue gets caught up in the excitement of the audience until the last minute.

One of the highlights of the show “demo run” takes place at the outdoor arena after a year of suspension for the facility's major refurbishment. It features the ever-popular drifting action and, on top of this, WRC (FIA World Rally Championship) cars make a special appearance in honour of Rally Japan having been confirmed to join 2020 WRC calendar for the first time in a decade. Two active WRC drivers on the active WRC cars give world class performances to make the crowd reach fever pitch. The 2020 show makes another new attempt to deliver live footage of a driving demonstrations program by a radio DJ & car pundit Piston Nishizawa to the indoors.

TOKYO AUTO SALON tries such a variety of approaches to cater to visitors of various generations with different tastes. We believe that each and every one must have enjoyed every minute of the rousing weekend. The genuineness and authenticity are what lead to the highest attendance.

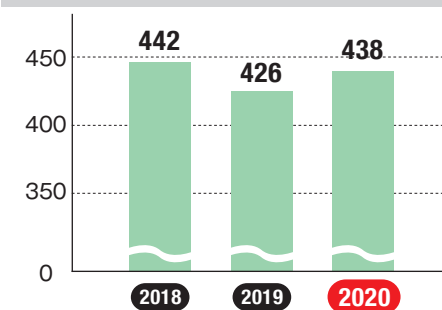

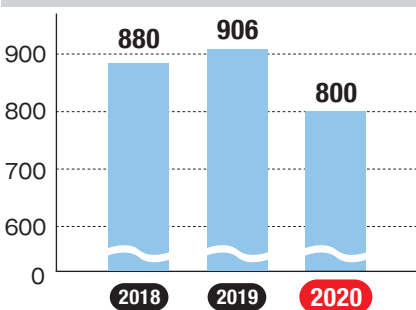

Trend in the number of exhibitors over the past three years

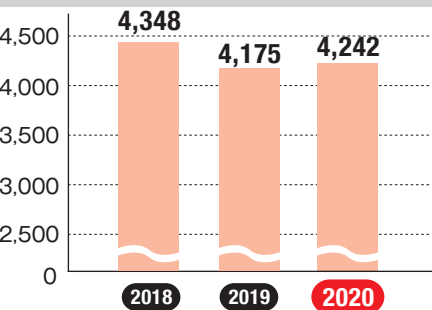
Number of exhibitors

Racing action and driving demonstrations are back in TAS after one year of suspension for the facility's renovations. “Rally Japan”, “drift car demo run” and “passenger ride experiences for kids” were the key content, of which Rally Japan featured the Toyota Yaris WRC driven by active drivers and, on top of that, the president of Toyota Motor Corporation Akio Toyoda as a surprise guest to whip the spectators up into a frenzy.



Collectible Car Auction

The third car auction in TOKYO AUTO SALON was jointly held by SUPER GT. Ten (10) collectible cars came up for “SUPER GT AUCTION – TAS” – the first-ever racing car auction in Japan. The most expensive car sold at this year's auction was the “1997 Porsche 935 K3 /80 by Kremer” that went under the hammer for ¥165 million. Prior to the auction, Koenigsegg had a press conference to introduce the Jesko for the first time in Japan.

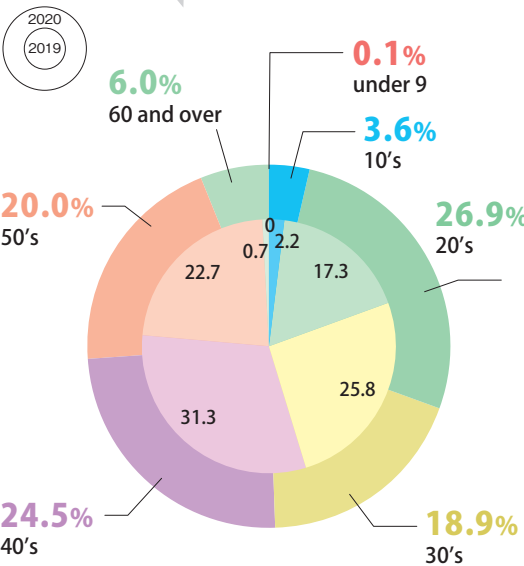


Live Performances

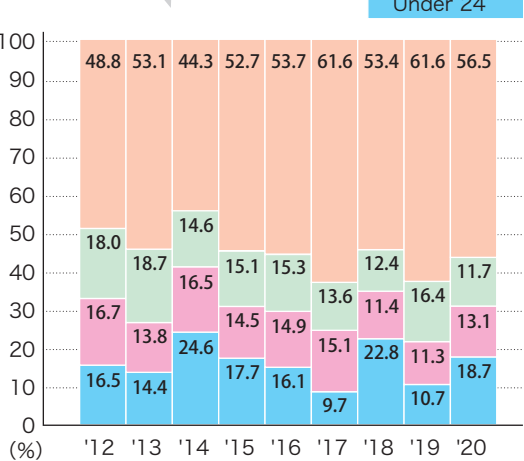

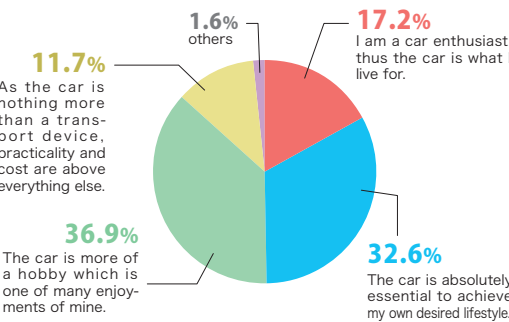
Age Group



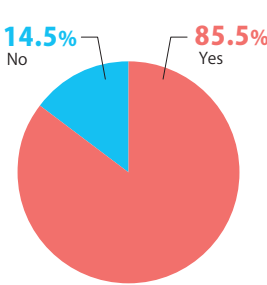
Trend in Age Group



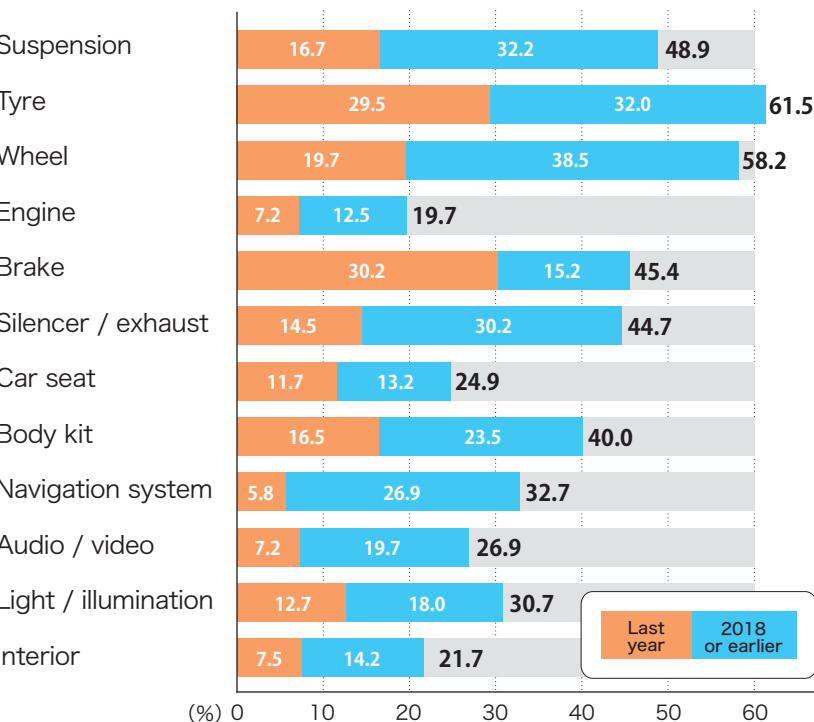
Q Which is most similar to your attitude about car?

TOKYO INTERNATIONAL CUSTOM CAR CONTEST 2020

Three winners each were voted in eight categories, of which the top winner was chosen as the category's best. TAS then engaged fans in voting the post-show online poll, and the top vote-getter won the Grand Prix.

Eligibility for Participation

Any vehicle taken part in TAS 2020 except purpose-built racing cars/past contest winners are eligible for an entry into the contest to compete on excellence in car custom achievements that satisfy requirements of the respective categories.

How the Winners Get Chosen

Winners in each category are determined by the visitor vote (as part of the questionnaire survey conducted during the course of the show on Friday and Saturday).

How the Grand Prix Get Chosen

TAS makes the eight top winners' photos accessible on our official website, and calls for the post-show online fan vote to choose one for the best - Custom Car Grand Prix of the year.

Contest Categories

The contest has below eight awards categorized according to how the car has been tuned/customized to the task it was intended to perform rather than the type of base vehicle by birth.



Award Winners in Each Category

Best Concept Car Award

Best Concept Car Award recognizes the most outstanding concept car of the year based on either 1) an original vehicle manufactured in an inventive approach or; 2) a production car-based vehicle heavily modified to achieve performance improvements as well as distinctive interior/exterior appearances, thus meant to be an advocator of a radically new concept. Cars entered in this category do not have to be street legal.

HKS GR SUPRA AERO entered by HKS Co., Ltd.

Best Dressed-up Car Award

Best Dressed-up Car Award recognizes the most outstanding dressed-up car of the year designed to pursue stylistic fineness. The key criteria for consideration are dress-up excellence in appearance, technique and ingenious ideas for exterior/interior customization, and as to how well-finished overall. Cars entered in this category basically are display-dedicated and not have to be street legal.

BLITZ GR SUPRA entered by BLITZ

Best Tuned Car Award

Best Tuned Car Award recognizes the most outstanding street-legal tuned car of the year that has been modified to produce even more power.

RE Amemiya Street-7 IMSA Edition entered by RE Amemiya

Best Sedan Award

Best Sedan Award recognizes the most outstanding street-legal sedan (saloon) of the year manufactured to achieve performance improvements as a desirable sedan. The key criteria for consideration are enhancement in the comfort of the cabin, unique ideas for dress-up and as to how well-finished overall.

SKYLINE 400R SPRINT CONCEPT entered by Nissan Motor Co., Ltd.

Best Minivan/Wagon Award

Best Minivan/Wagon Award recognizes the most outstanding street-legal minivan/wagon of the year manufactured to achieve performance improvements as a desirable minivan/wagon. The key criteria for consideration are enhancement in the accessibility of the utility space, unique ideas for dress-up and as to how well-finished overall.

CRYSTALEYE Late 30 ALPHARD entered by CRYSTALEYE & BODY SHOP KIKUTA

Best SUV Award

Best SUV Award recognizes the most outstanding street-legal SUV of the year manufactured to achieve performance improvements as a desirable SUV. The key criteria for consideration are enhancement in the accessibility of the utility space, unique ideas for interior/exterior appearances and as to how well-finished overall.

Duraturn w/ hazard Hilux entered by Exizzle-line Co., Ltd.

Best K-car/Compact Car Award

Best K-car/Compact Car Award recognizes the most outstanding street-legal K-car/compact car (light motor vehicle) of the year manufactured to achieve performance improvements as a desirable k-car/compact car. The key criteria for consideration are enhancement in the accessibility of the utility space, unique ideas for dress-up and as to how well-finished overall.

DAMD N-VAN MALIBU entered by DAMD Inc.

Best Imported Car Award

Best Imported Car Award recognizes the most outstanding street-legal imported car of the year manufactured to achieve performance improvements as a desirable imported car. The key criteria for consideration are tuning excellence in engine and suspension, enhancement in the accessibility of the utility space, unique ideas for dress-up and as to how well-finished overall.

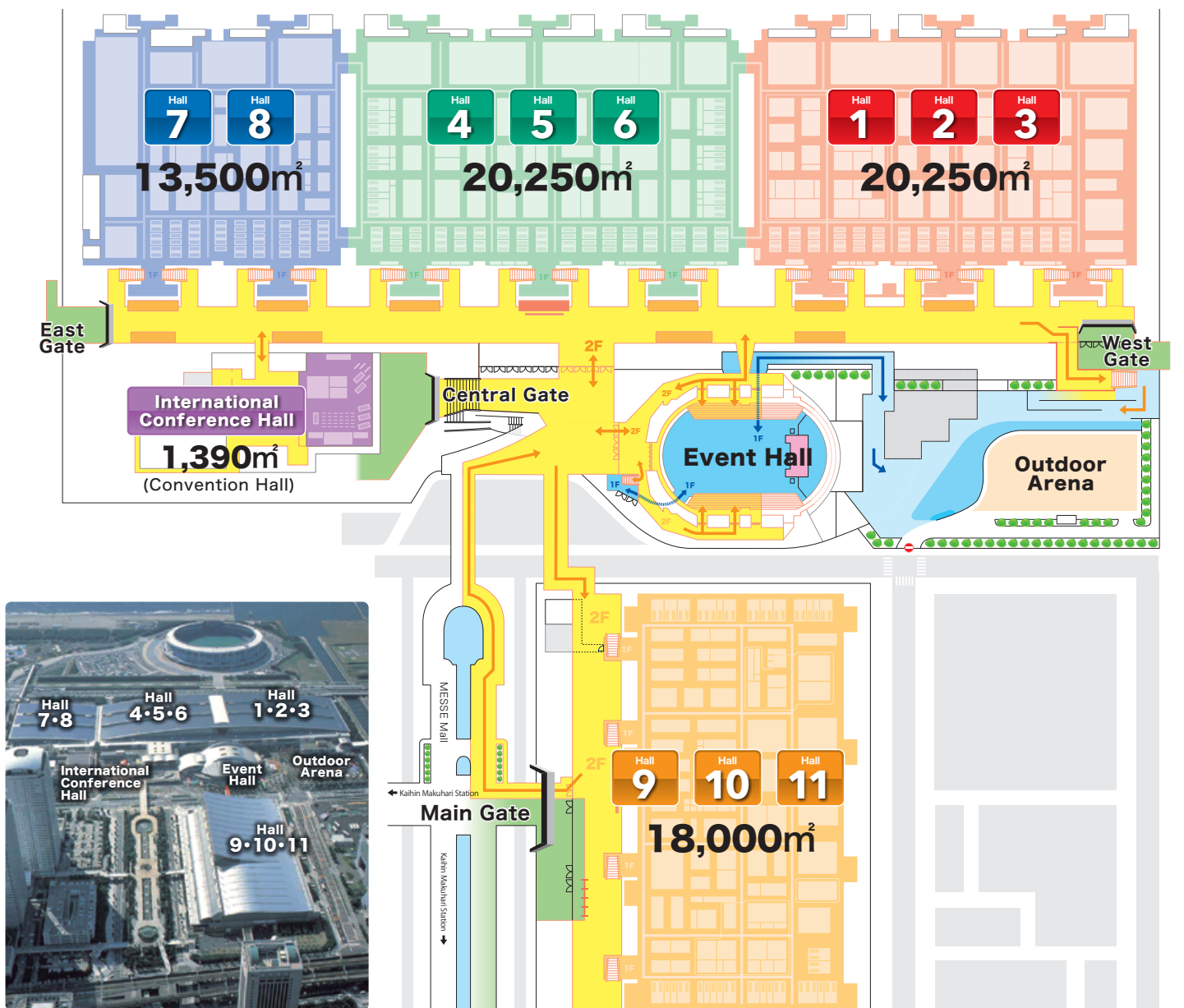
Trade Visitor

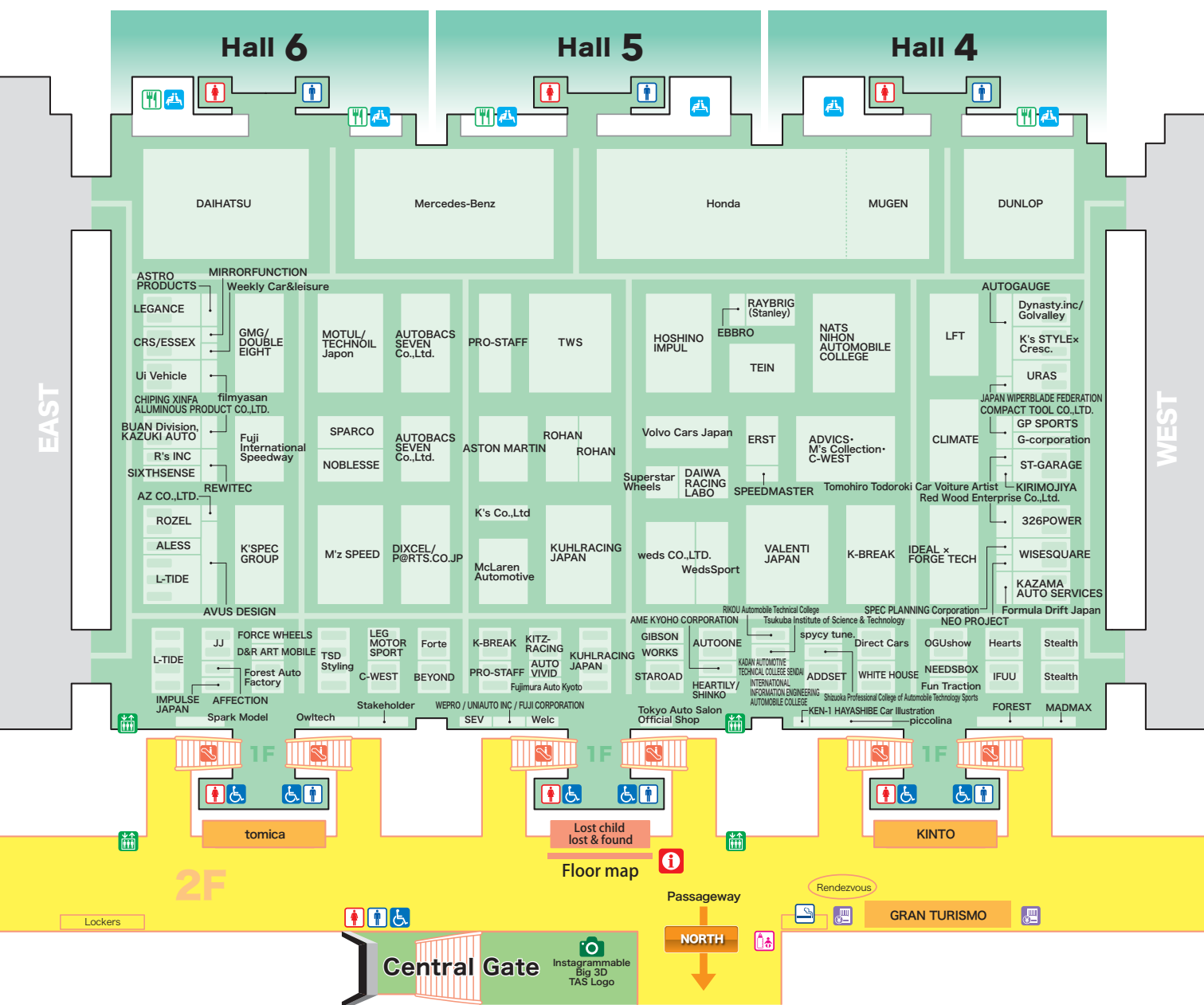
Venue Overview

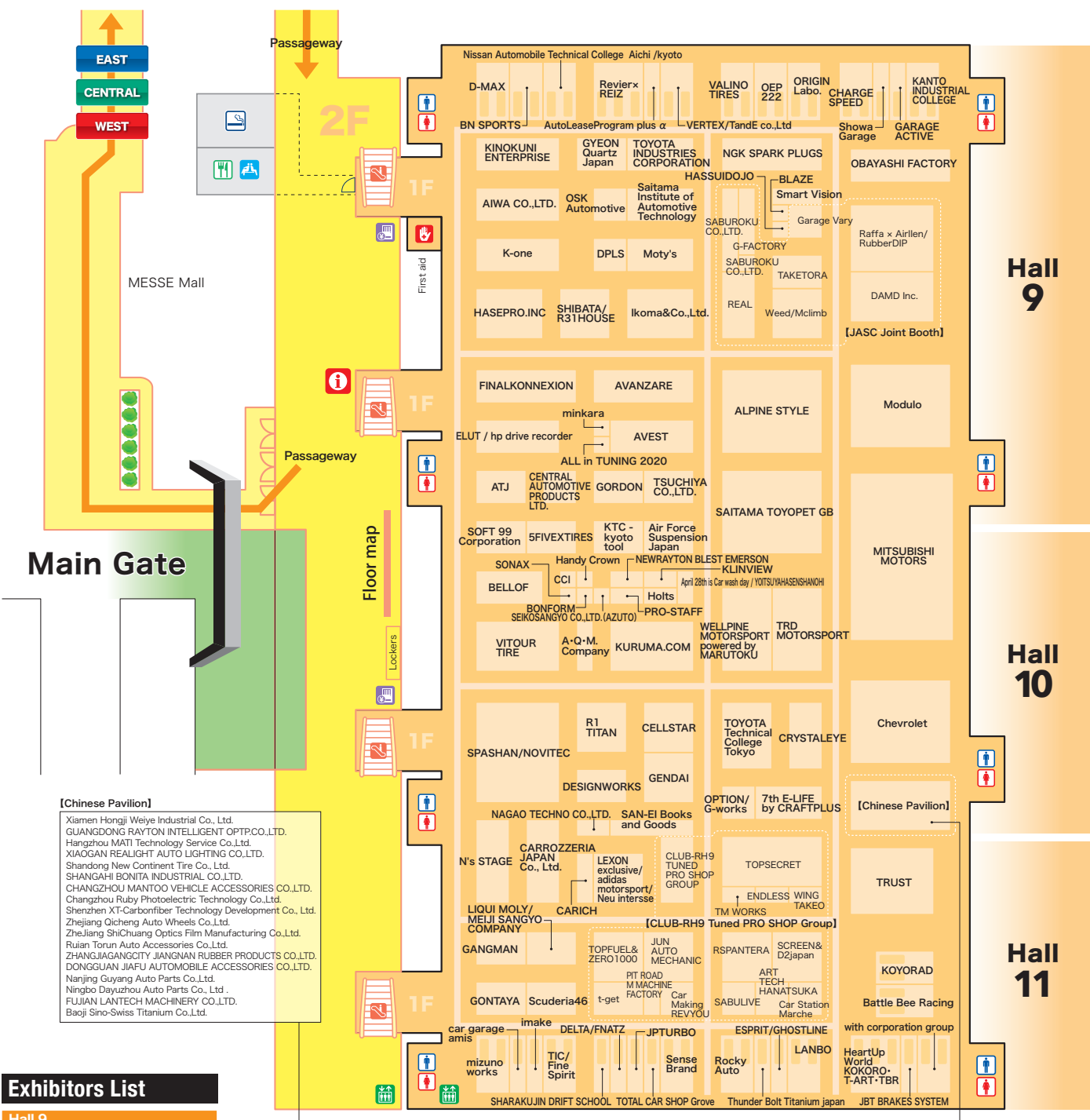
