TOKYO AUTO SALON 2010 with NAPAC MEDIA (PRESS) RULES AND REGULATIONS

- Parking facilities have decreased dramatically due mainly to development plans by Chiba Prefecture. Given these circumstances, considerable congestion and inconvenience are expected throughout the duration of the Exhibition. When attending Tokyo Auto Salon 2010 with NAPAC, we kindly request you use public transportation wherever possible.
- Considerable congestion is also anticipated at the press reception counter depending on the day and time of attendance. Your patience and understanding of this matter would be greatly appreciated.
- Upon arrival at the Exhibition, please present your "Credential Application Receipt" and "Business Card" at the press reception counter to receive "Media Credentials (Press Pass)." Each "Press Pass" is valid for one (1) day only. In covering the Exhibition, please report to the press reception counter daily to receive the relevant "Press Pass."
- Please be advised that the issue of "Press Passes" may be denied in the event documents as prescribed under the relevant rules and regulations are not presented.
- The transfer or temporary loan of "Press Passes" to a third party is strictly prohibited.
- To assist in the easy confirmation of credentials, please wear / display "Press Passes" in a readily identifiable manner when covering / reporting on the Exhibition.
- A movie camera sticker issued by the Tokyo Auto Salon Public Relations Office is required for all video recording equipment. Please apply for the issue of stickers as appropriate when registering at the press reception counter.
- In covering / reporting on the Exhibition, media may be requested to verify their identity. Accordingly, we ask that you maintain on your person the necessary identification documents at all times. Overseas media are asked to present their passports on request.
- Individual authorization must be obtained prior to the photographing and / or video recording of exhibits, exhibition booths and exhibitors (including companions).
- Authorization must be obtained prior to the photographing and / or video recording of individuals, including the general public, who can be readily identified.
- Separate authorization must be obtained from the D1 Grand Prix Office to cover / report on, photograph and / or video record the D1 Demo.
- "Press Rooms" have been set up at Exhibition Halls 5 and 6. Each "Press Room" is equipped with Internet access.
- To facilitate the smooth application and registration of "Press Passes" in the future, please forward a copy of the Tokyo Auto Salon 2010 with NAPAC newspaper or magazine article to the following office at a later date.
